



HOW TO RE-OPEN FACILITIES AFTER COVID-197

WOULD GUESTS BE WILLING TO ACCEPT CERTAIN LIMITATIONS IN ORDER TO GO BACK TO LEISURE FACILITIES AGAIN?

Clip 'n Climb has carried out a three-week study, and asked leisure facilities guests to give their point of view, on measures that could be taken within facilities to ensure safety while still maximizing guest experience.

The study was completed by over **700** respondents from all over the world.




WHO ARE THE RESPONDENTS?


Most of the respondents come from the UK, but **countries from over the globe** are represented which allow a global overview.

The respondents **come** on a quite regular basis (51%)

The audience surveyed visit leisure facilities:

With family (78%)


With friends (42%)


As a chaperone (9%)

The respondents tend to come for an hour or two in a leisure facility (58%).






COVID-19 RISK MITIGATION MEASURES

High interest for limited capacity and social distancing (82% and 79%), following by online booking and contactless payment options.

Wearing gloves, a mask or having a tracking app would not encourage guests to come back to leisure facilities. We have noticed that the use of masks is more present in France and Spain, while gloves are not relevant in any country.

69% of respondents were **in support of a designated area** in the facility to have fun. However, Spanish and German respondents were generally not positive to this suggestion.

Would you be more reassured taking part in fun activities...






COVID-19 RISK MITIGATION MEASURES

Concerning the period when people will feel confident enough to go back to leisure facilities, 52% stated that they would wait a few weeks after lockdown is over for the situation to stabilize. 11% would wait until a vaccine is found.

We have noticed that Germany is a country with another vision on this question as **58% of queried**Germans were ready to go back as soon as lockdown is over. We have to take into account that the situation is at another level in this country.


When would you be ready to visit again an entertainment facility?






COVID-19 RISK MITIGATION MEASURES

We also discussed the idea of timeslots and what would be the amount of time within a leisure facility they find reasonable. 2 hours or less is ideal for 84% of the respondents. In Germany thoses queried stated that 45 minutes wasn't enough.








BEST PRACTICES

We asked respondents to tell us their ideas on measures that could be implemented within leisure facilities to reassure them.

Take the following list as various suggestions from visitors and hints to get ready!

CONCLUSION



Guests are willing to come back when the situation is stabilized. They are ready to follow rules and be adaptative but expect facilities operators to implement overall social distancing measures and communicate about them.

Guests are willing to wear masks, but would prefer if capacity is not limited.

So, you might have to rethink your schedule and your booking system to make sure everyone can find the perfect timeslot! Having sanitization stations across the facility will be the norm to reassure guests.

As a reminder, the presented results are just a consultation. You can use these as a guide to reopen your doors. It is up to you and your local authorities to make the right decisions.
